What is My Barrowcliff?

The aim of My Barrowcliff is to improve the quality of life in Barrowcliff by helping the community solve local problems, improve the environment, reduce crime, make available better neighbourhood facilities and improve opportunities for jobs and skills.

The initiative has brought together a broad partnership of organisations who have worked with the local community to look closely at what issues and problems currently exist in the area and what improvements and changes could be made to address them. Looking at all the issues together and in a joined up way, provides the opportunity for a new approach to planning the estate's future.

Community consultation

A process of research and analysis has been carried out to establish the key issues and priorities for local residents living in Barrowcliff. This combination of both statistical data and anecdotal evidence has provided a rich picture of what life is like in Barrowcliff today.

Local community consultation has also taken place which has added grassroots knowledge from residents of Barrowcliff to this picture. This consultation and involvement is an ongoing process and the action plan will develop over time as more and more local people get involved.
